



What is a typical class/camp like?

- 5 minutes warm up/ large motor work (writing letters in the air/eyes closed, pre-writing/ writing task on chalkboard wall)
- 10 minutes of medium motor work (using exploding paint in giant sized handwriting lines, shaving cream, or other really cool mediums). We teach handwriting error recognition, touchpoints on the writing lines and work on sequencing.
- 15 minutes of small motor/ fine motor work/ handwriting - working in the workbooks. We use a variety on multisensory programs. Younger students in preschool - Kindergarten - work on fine motor skills, coloring, cutting with scissors, ✨ writing generalization, more multi-sensory writing.
- 5 minutes of visual memory or reversal techniques.
- 5 minutes of parent training.
